	Option	Description	
AC	COUNTING	The Accounting option allows access to information regard- ing meters, accounting, security, error accounting, and pro- gram version.	
DIA	AGNOSTICS	The <i>Diagnostics</i> option allows testing of various machine functions related to sound, video, hopper, bill acceptor, and printer. Some functions may not be available depending upon machine configuration. The <i>Play History</i> option allows access to information regarding machine history and game history.

EV	ENT LOGS	The Event Logs option provides access to information regarding the events log, the cashout log, and the progressive log.	
	MODIFY METERS	The Modify Meters option allows for clearing of period meters.

	OUT OF SERVICE	ATTENDANT MENU ONLY – displays "Out of Service" on the video monitor. This renders the machine inoperable without turning the power off.

ACCOUNTING	MACHINE MASTER ACCOUNTING	Allows viewing of master accounting meter data that may cover the life of the machine.
DIAGNOSTICS	MACHINE PERIOD ACCOUNTING	Allows viewing of meter information since the period meters were last cleared.
PLAY HISTO-	GAME GROUP ACCOUNTING	A summary of game master meters for all games configured for the machine.
EVENT LOGS	GAME ACCOUNTING	Allows viewing of game master and game specific accounting meters.
MODIFY METERS	GAME SET RECALL	Allows viewing of game set information.
SETUP	SECURITY	Allows viewing of security accounting meters.
OUT OF SERVICE	ERROR	Allows viewing of error accounting meters.
	PROGRAM VERSION INFORMATION	Allows viewing of version information of both machine and peripheral firmware.
	PRINT METERS	Allows printing of terminal and game statistical information, financial information and verification information.
